# IAS journal agreement

- ISSIA members have reduced publication fees in IAS, i.e. 150 EUR instead of 200 EUR. At the end of 2021 ISSIA will pay for this difference to IAS for ISSIA members who published in IAS. This concerns 5 submissions to IAS at this date.
- Regular and student ISSIA members are entitled to the printed version of IAS issues only if they select the "membership with subscription" option. In this membership a reduced

- subscription to IAS (40 EUR) is included (i.e. 50+40 EUR). ISSIA will pay IAS for the subscription (40 EUR each) of ISSIA members who will choose to subscribe for IAS.
- ISSIA will provide additional financial support of 1000 EUR to IAS to cover advertisements in IAS and printed versions of IAS for honorary members.

# Hans Jørgen Gottlieb Gundersen Best Paper Award

Ales Kladnik paid tribute to Hans Jørgen Gottlieb Gundersen, died on February 01, 2021, who was an important figure in the Stereology community. ISSIA received an anonymous donation to initiate a fund for a best paper award in his honor. The award in the first year will be 2000€.

A call will be published to ISSIA members and on the ISSIA website to describe the practical modalities of the award.

## **Image Analysis & Stereology journal report**

- Three issues per year, 17 papers in 2020 on 218 pages
- JCR impact factor (2019) is 0,55
- 176 submitted papers, ~10% acceptance rate
- 21 papers currently in review
- Nonprofit model, works on dedication of all involved
- For five papers for ISSIA member the fee was reduced
- Paper publication charge 200 EUR to (partly) cover printing costs
- The technical editors are Primož Peterlin, who edits articles in Latex, and a new colleague Nataša Pollak Kristl, who edit articles in MS Word

## Benefits of ISSIA membership:
